 UNPAN-DPADM will update the existing UNPAN User Survey and will share it with Partners for further feedback and finalization

 UNPAN-DPADM will start an online discussion platform for continuous collaboration (Linkedin will be considered as first option)



 UNPAN-DPADM will update Discover UNPAN page and will provide more detailed information for each partner organization. A template will be designed for this purpose and partners will be requested to provide more detailed information based on the template



- UNPAN-DPADM will create yearly progress reports in addition to regular monthly ones
- UNPAN-DPADM will launch 6 more courses in Spanish that was developed in collaboration with ICAP



- ICAP will consider requesting old hardware which is no longer supported by the UN IT Department
- UNPAN-DPADM and UNECA will discuss possible collaboration areas in the first week of October in NY



- ARADO and other partners in the Arab region will consider translating some of the existing e-courses into Arabic
- ARADO will also offer UNPAN the training courses in Arabic that they have for dissemination via the UNPAN Platform



UNPAN-DPADM will implement so that UNPAN can propose the next steps to UNPAN users i.e. related documents, other people who is working in this area etc.



- UNPAN-DPADM will make sure that the new site complies with W3C accessibility Standards
- UNPAN-DPADM will consider linking UNPAN e-courses with UN Academic Impact as well as with UNITAR



 UNPAN-DPADM will draft a set of standardized marketing tools for distribution by UNPAN Partners in their respective regions/networks and this will also include best practices from UNPAN Members



- IPMA-HR will produce a summary of their fee based services to be displayed in UNPAN North America page
- UNPAN-DPADM and also all UNPAN partners will reconsider the name "UNPAN Resource Persons"



- All UNPAN Partners will further evaluate the new tools and provide their feedback to UNPAN-DPADM
- UNPAN-DPADM will consider
 - allowing FaceBook users to log-in UNPAN automatically by using their FaceBook ID
 - Implementing a browser add-on tool which will enable content contribution with one click from the user's web browser



- UNPAN-DPADM will provide a disclaimer stating the compatible browsers that the new UNPAN platform supports
- UNPAN-DPADM will reconsider using flickr while linking an image to a content



 UNPAN-DPADM will enable tagging in local languages (especially for languages that use different encoding such as Arabic, Chinese, Russian)



• UNECLAC will share its Spanish courses on e-government with UNPAN for dissemination. UNPAN-DPADM will report all activity (participation, enrollment, completion, learner details etc) to UNECLAC related to its courses on a monthly basis



• All UNPAN Partners will review the new UNPAN Partner Guidelines after the meeting (which will be updated by feedback received during the meeting) and guidelines will be finalized by Oct 31, 2010.
