
Complaints received by the European



33% of complaints was related to lack of transparency in the EU Administration. This included refusal of information and of access to documents.




Access to Information – Global View






Access to Information – Regional View


Access to Information - Europe

FOIA - Timeline of Selected Countries






OGD Catalogues – Global View








OGD Catalogues – Regional View





OGD Catalogues – Timeline






FOIA - Major Findings

- Europe is leading in open government data legislation.
- FOIA varies in scope from country to country.
- FOIA is used mainly by the media and the civil society in general.
- Most citizens are not aware of its existence.
- Establishing FOIA is the only the first step.
- There is a need for effective implementation, monitoring and evaluation of FOIA.
- Most FOIAs do not contain specific legislation for providing Open Government Data Catalogues.






DPA - Major Findings

Institutional Arrangement




Open Government Data by Region



Open Government Data* by Regional




E-Participation by Region



E-Participation Index Regional Averages




E-Government Development by Region







- The "Right" Data and "Right" Services
 - Demand-driven
 - Enhance quality of data
 - Value-added
- Create a culture of open government through training and institutional building, including the capacity for proper evaluation and monitoring
- Connect all citizens online, especially the vulnerable groups





UN Public Administration Country Studies (UNPACS)



- Research (first phase)
 - Open government data
 - Government institution restructuring
 - Codes of conduct of public service
 - E-Government strategies/policies
 - CIOs or equivalents
 - National institutions/systems on citizen engagement, etc.
- Enable governments and all stakeholders in making evidence-based decisions for the implementation of internationally agreed development agenda including the MDGs


