Adoption of the agenda and other organizational matters

Proposed dates and proposed provisional agenda for the second meeting of the Committee of Experts on Public Administration

In its resolution 2001/45, entitled “Restructuring and revitalization of the Group of Experts on the United Nations Programme in Public Administration and Finance”, the Economic and Social Council agreed to transform the Group into the Committee of Experts on Public Administration. In its resolution 2002/40 the Economic and Social Council agreed that the second meeting of the Committee should be held in 2003. According to the terms of reference of the Committee adopted by the Council, the Council is expected to adopt the agenda of topics to be discussed by the Committee. It is proposed that the Committee meet in New York for one week, from 7 to 11 April 2003. The proposed agenda for the second meeting of the Committee is contained in the annex to the present document and is submitted to the Council for review and approval.

The Secretariat will submit a paper on the general trends of United Nations activities in public administration for the review and guidance of the Committee.
