#### Introduction

Upon invitation received by the United Nations Department of Economic and Social Affairs (UNDESA), NGO Section/ECOSOC, the Legião da Boa Vontade - LBV (Legion of Good Will – LGW) will promote a preparatory regional workshop with the participation of Non-Governmental Organizations – NGOs of Latin America and African countries (Portuguese language communities). The workshop will cover the theme: *The eradication of poverty in the least developed countries*, and it will take place at the ParlaMundi of the LGW, in Brasilia, capital of Brazil on March 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup>, 2004.

# **Objectives:**

- To hold a preparatory regional workshop together with interested NGOs from Latin America and African countries. The NGO working groups will propose an agenda that promotes communication and exchange of information among organizations to develop projects with focus on *The eradication of poverty in the least developed countries*, making possible the transference of Social Technologies developed, implemented and experienced in Latin American countries, which may be implemented in Portuguese speaking LDCs of the African continent.
- To identify useful strategies, to improve human being's worthy quality
  of life with job opportunities, especially on gender equality issues,
  concrete recommendations for social and economic development; to
  bring up solutions for the world economy, the social disparity, health
  problems; to facilitate cultural exchange of information, educational

cooperation, encouraging the universal respect towards the human rights and freedom; to reinforce and contribute to the increased awareness and mobilization of Latin American and African NGOs to support the Millennium Development Goals (MDG).

• The *LGW*, a Brazilian Non-Governmental Organization in General Consultative Status with ECOSOC, with branches in 5 Latin American Countries, assumes the role of articulating a network of Latin American and African organizations that will contribute to the *Eradication of Poverty in the Least Developed Countries*.

# Proposal for the event

Considering the problems pointed out by the United Nations Agencies regarding African Least Development Countries the workshop will cover the following sub-themes:

- > Eradication of extreme poverty and hunger;
- > Promotion of gender equity issues and the empowerment of women;
- ➤ Fight against HIV/AIDS;
- ➤ Alternatives of creation of jobs and incomes;
- ➤ Mobilization of resources and realization of global partnerships for social development.

# **Description**

The 2-day workshop will approach the theme: *Eradication of poverty in the least developed countries*. The event will start with an open Magna Conference addressed to local authorities and to the public in general. The NGO(s) proposals and recommendations for the High Level Segment of ECOSOC will be discussed in the format of working groups with the participation of NGOs invited, assembled according to their working practices for sharing expertise. Each working group will be composed by at least 10 NGO(s) representatives with a rapport to write their concrete recommendations and proposals as well as practical approaches for their implementation.

The lectures and the conferences will be presented in Portuguese language, with simultaneous translation to English and Spanish.
