6. Review of United Nations activities in the area of public administration.

Documentation

The Secretariat will present the highlights of the United Nations programme on public administration and development for the past biennium (E/C.16/2006/5). Presentations will also be made on the *World Public Sector Report*, the United Nations Online Network in Public Administration and Finance (UNPAN), the Seventh Global Forum on Reinventing Government and its related regional preparatory meetings.

7. Proposed programme of work and agenda for the sixth session of the Committee of Experts.

The Committee of Experts will review its programme of work and make recommendations to the Economic and Social Council on the agenda for its sixth session.
