## A/RES/246 (III). International facilities for the promotion of training in public administration

The General Assembly,

*Recognizing* the need for international facilities which will provide adequate administrative training for an increasing number of candidates of proved ability recruited on a wide geographical basis, but mainly from the countries in greatest need of access to the principles, procedures and methods of modern administration,

## Resolves that

- 1. An International Centre for Training in Public Administration shall be established under the direction of the United Nations;
- 2. The Secretary-General shall report detailed arrangements for such a centre to the Economic and Social Council for consideration;
- 3. The Secretary-General shall include in his budget estimates for the financial year 1950 a programme implementing the objectives of the present resolution.
