GENERAL INFORMATION

1. Date and Place

The Consultative Meeting on "*E-Government for Sustainable Development*" will be organized by the Division for Public Administration and Development Management (DPADM), of the United Nations Department of Economic and Social Affairs (UNDESA) and will be hosted by United Nations Project Office on Governance (UNPOG) in partnership with the Ministry of Government Administration and Home Affairs (MOGAHA) of the Republic of Korea as the preparatory process for the 2016 United Nations E-Government Survey. This event will be held at Best Western Premier Seoul Garden Hotel from 9 to 10 February 2015.

The Consultative Meeting will begin at 9:00 a.m. on Monday, 9 February 2015 and end at 12:30 p.m. on Tuesday, 10 February 2015. The Meeting will be small groups of 8 to 10 people with discussions at roundtables. The discussion notes will be shared in a Plenary Session in order to capture all participant's views.

Airport ↔ Hotels

Various public transportation options are available from the airports to the hotels. Depending on the means of transportation, the fee varies from KRW 3,850 (Airport Railroad) and KRW 10,000 (Airport Limousine Bus) to KRW 50,000 (taxi).

WEATHER

Korea has four distinct seasons - spring, summer, fall and winter. Winter lasts from December to February. During the month of February, the average temperature in Seoul ranges from approximately 25 to 35°F, -3 to -1°C. TIME DIFFERENCE

Seoul uses Korea Standard Time (KST), which is 9 hours ahead of GMT (standard time).



ATTIRE

The weather in Seoul during the period of the Consultative Meeting is late winter. Participants are strongly advised to bring warm outfits.



ELECTRICITY SUPPLY The voltage in Korea is 220 volts at 60 Hz.



FOREIGN EXCHANGE AND BANKING

The monetary unit is the Won (KRW, denoted by \clubsuit). Korean monetary units are composed of 10, 50, 100, and 500 coins, and 1,000, 5,000, 10,000 and 50,000 notes. The exchange rate is approximately KRW 1,078 / USD 1 (as of 19 January 2015). All major credit cards such as American Express, Visa and Master Card are accepted for payment of hotel bills.



TIPPING

Tipping is not a traditional Korean custom. A 10% service charge is added to your bill at all tourist hotels and so tipping is not expected. It is not necessary to tip a taxi driver unless he assists you with luggage or provides an extra service.

MOBILE PHONE (ROAMING)



CDMA cellular systems are widely used in Korea. SK Telecom and KT are providing a SIM card roaming service to allow you to use your GSM subscription in Korea.
